BCHC EDUCATION PROGRAMS

1. OFFICER ORIENTATION

Meeting of state officers once a year. Purpose is to provide leadership training to new officers from each unit. Officer Manuals contain complete details of each position. Other pertinent materials are given including "Gentle Use" information and Education Summary Sheets.
